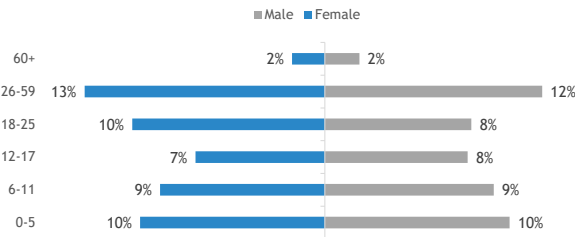

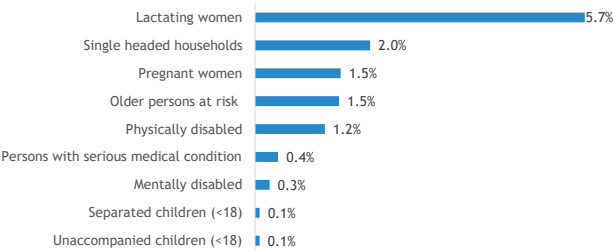

## Age and sex breakdown of IDP camp population



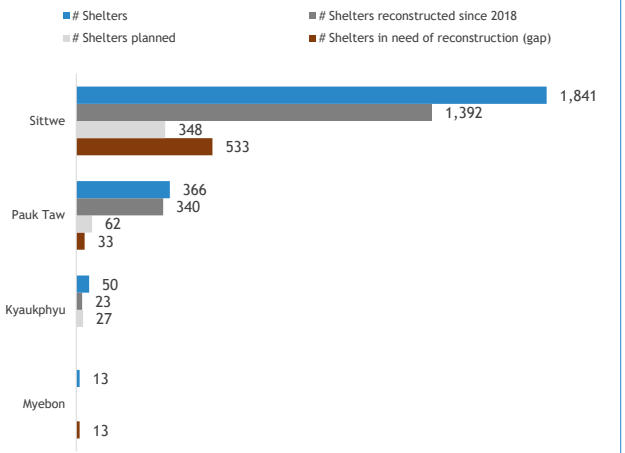
## Persons with specific needs in IDP camps (13% of individuals)

## Status of shelter units in IDP camps by Township

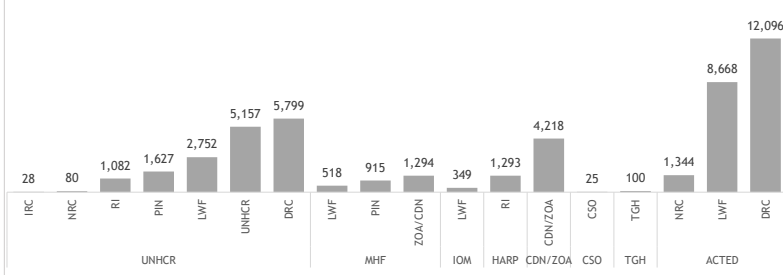

## # HH reached with NFI distributions by organisation/partner



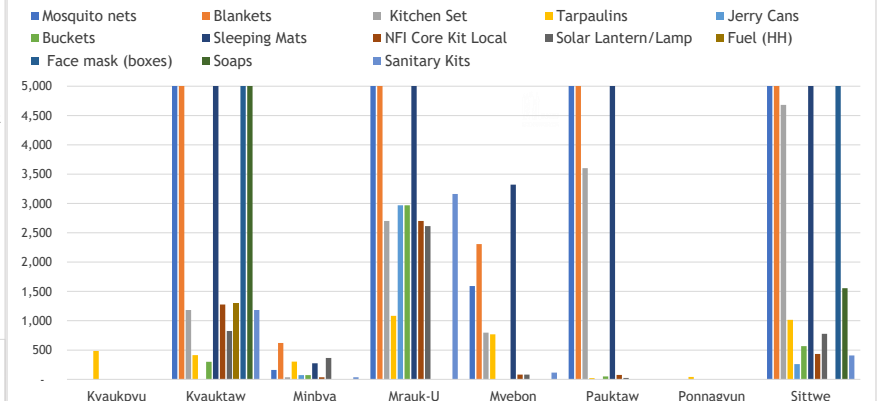
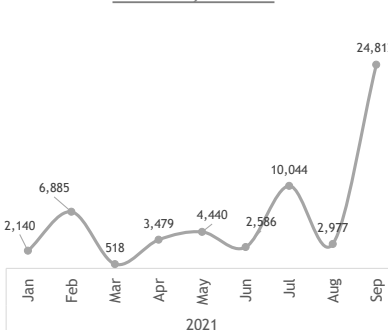
