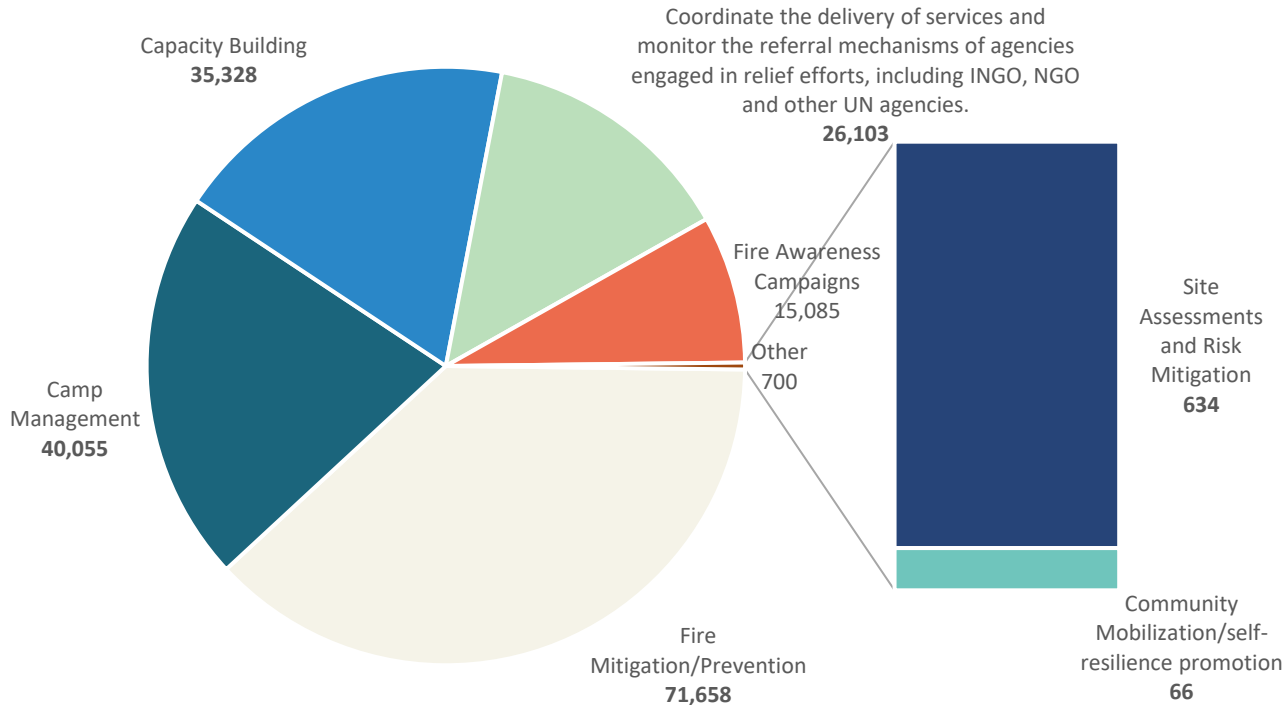


4Ws Activities for July 2023-Completed

IDPs in 187 IDP sites benefited from CCCM activities detailed as follows:
