

Assessment overview

A joint IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Beletweyne in January 2022. The operation was led by local government counterparts, Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs (MOHA), CCCM partners, CESDO, DAN, DRC, HCRI, HIDIG, HIWA, Islamic Relief, Maamulka, SOYDA and WARDI. 92 IDP sites were identified hosting 18,785 households or 112,387 individuals.

9 IDP sites (10%) were identified as having extreme (always flood) risk of flooding which will most likely affect 7,926 IDPs hosted in these sites. 40 IDP sites (43%) were identified as having high (flood frequently) risk of flooding which will most likely affect 52,659 IDPs hosted in these sites

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

53% of IDP sites (49 sites) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
