

Summary

CCCM Cluster members participated in reporting this month: ACTED, MHD, HAI, TRC, White helmets, SDI, AHA and Bahar.

- Care and maintenance: Care and maintenance for the key facilities and infrastructure.
- Camp Management: Regular needs and gaps identification, facilitation of coordination meetings, coordination of multisectoral services provision and conducting FGDs.
- Community Mobilization/Self-resilience Promotion: Awareness sessions to IDPs by NGOs/Committees on different subjects and discussing exit strategy.
- Establishment of temporary collective centres: It was established to be used exclusively in emergency situations. It contains 15 large tents and can accommodate up to 300 people.
- Site Assessments and Risk Mitigation: Incident reporting.
- Coordinate the delivery of services and monitor the referral mechanisms of agencies engaged in relief efforts, including INGO, NGO and other UN agencies: Coordinate the delivery of services and monitor the referral mechanisms of agencies engaged in relief efforts, including INGO, NGO and other UN agencies.
- Fire Mitigation/Prevention: Distribute or refill the fire extinguishers, distribution of different fire mitigation tool and fire prevention training for community committees.
