Don't forget that a CCCM Cluster needs to have a CCCM Cluster Response Strategy in place, too. This is a separate document, although it must be aligned with the HNO and HRP. Planning to develop the Response Strategy to the same timeframe as the HRP is often the most efficient use of time. You can find guidance and an example timeline in **Toolkit Section 4.1 Strategic Planning**.
