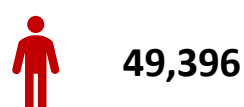

01 CONTEXT OVERVIEW

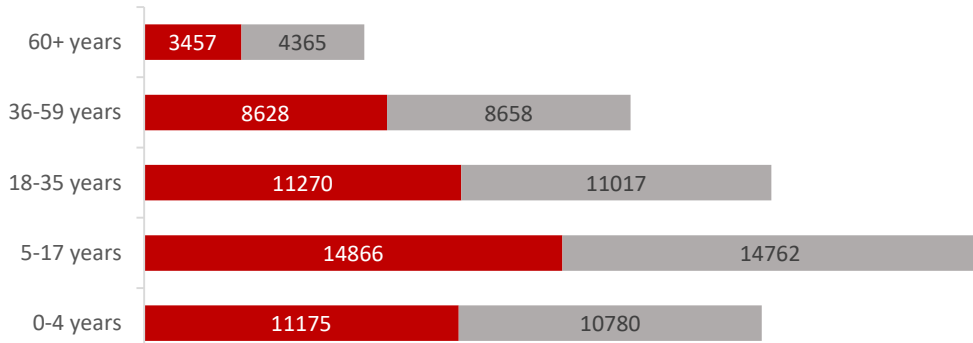
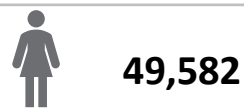
Population in the IDP Sites in Unity state changes frequently because of multiple triggering factors such as flooding, conflict, food insecurity, lack of livelihood opportunities, and high flow of the returnees from Sudan. Thus gaps and need of services vary accordingly. For better gap and need analysis, DRC CCCM conducts population headcount and intention survey in the IDP sites in Rubkona and Guit Counties every quarter to inform stakeholders for effective programming.

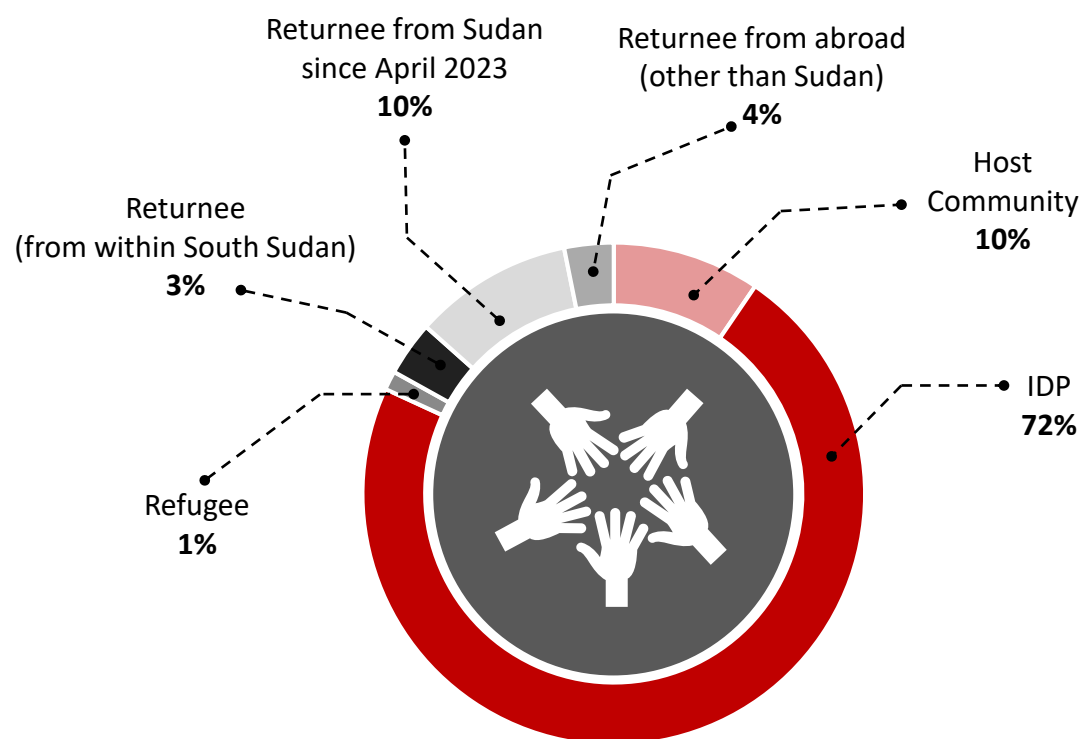

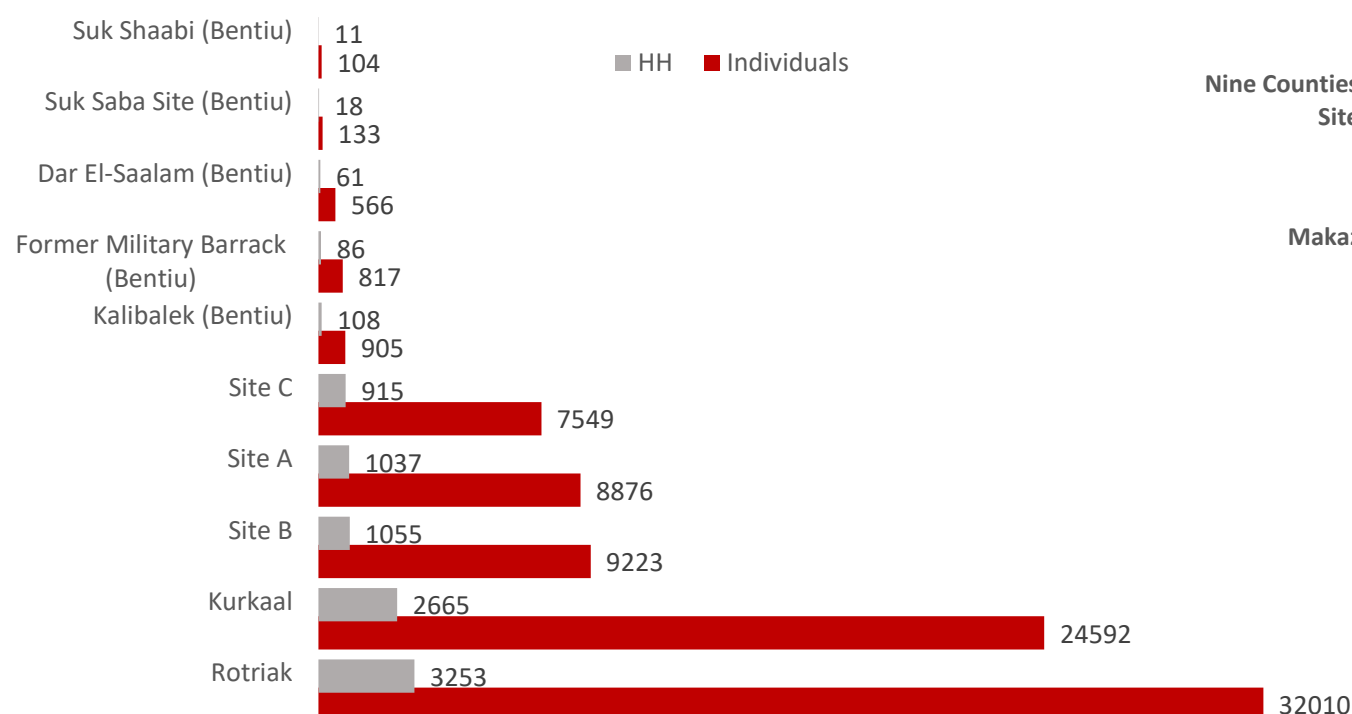
Age-Gender breakdown of the population



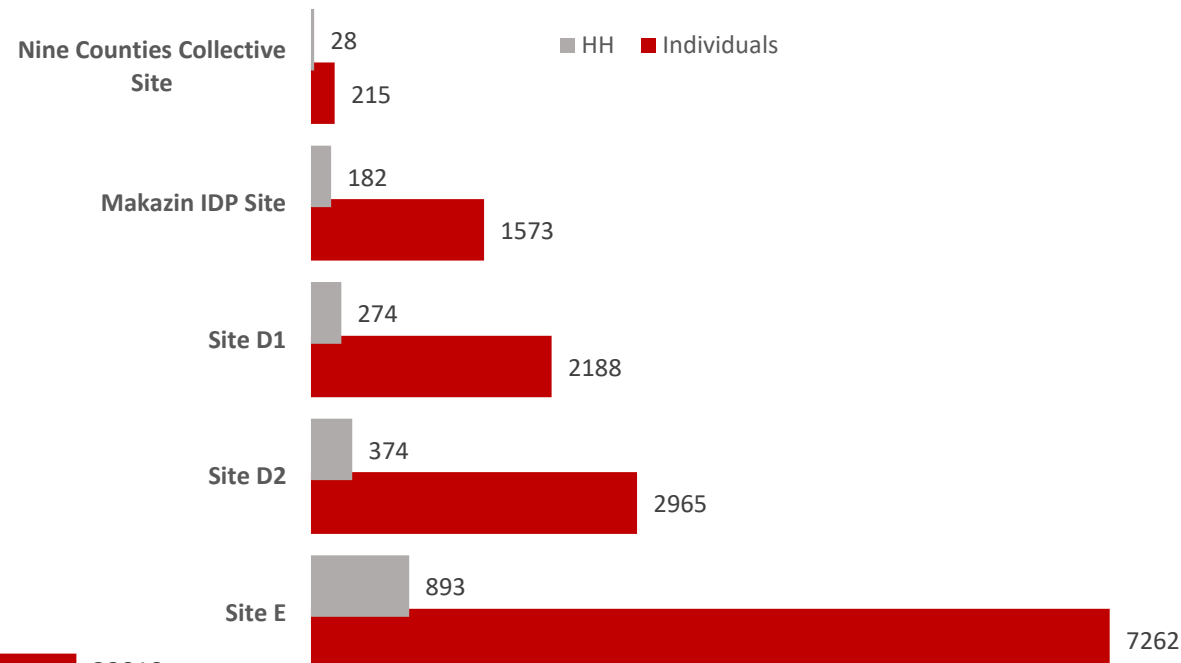

Population in Guit IDP Sites

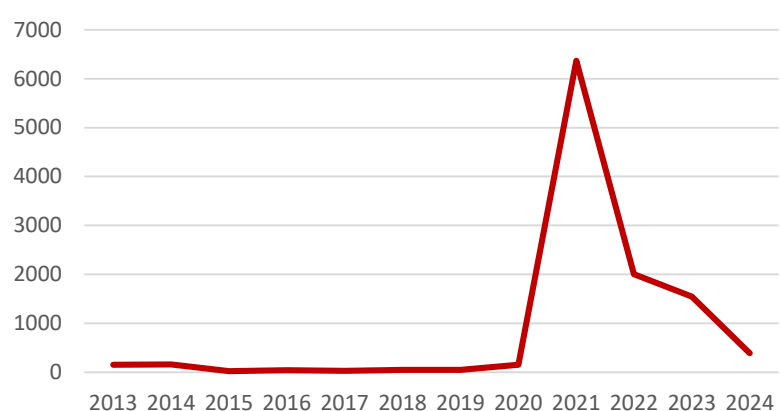

Year of arrival of the families to the sites

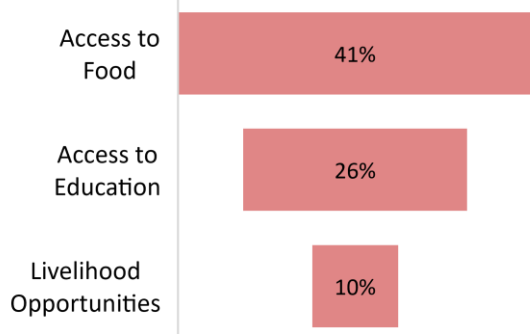
- Some displaced families due to the conflict have been residing in some collective sites since 2013.

- Mostly the flood affected population from around Unity State took refuge in the IDP sites since 2021.

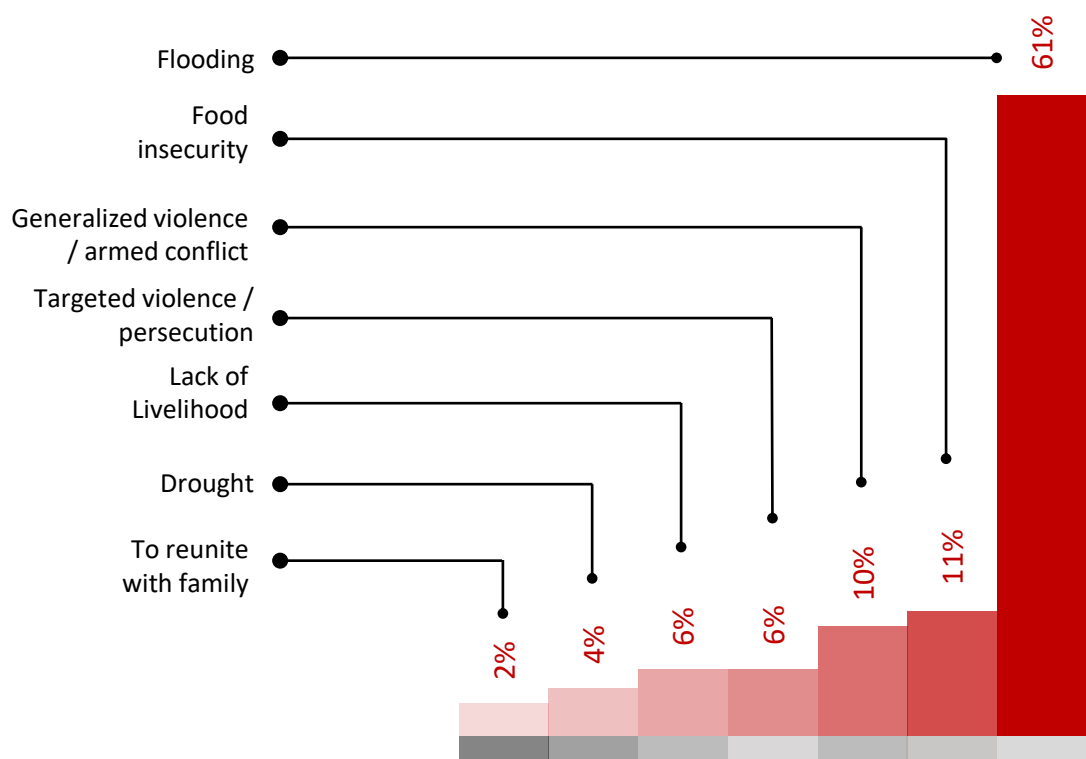
- The situation exacerbated after the influx of returnees due to the Sudan crisis since 2023.

- There is a growing trend of part of the family leaving the sites mainly to seek livelihood opportunities.

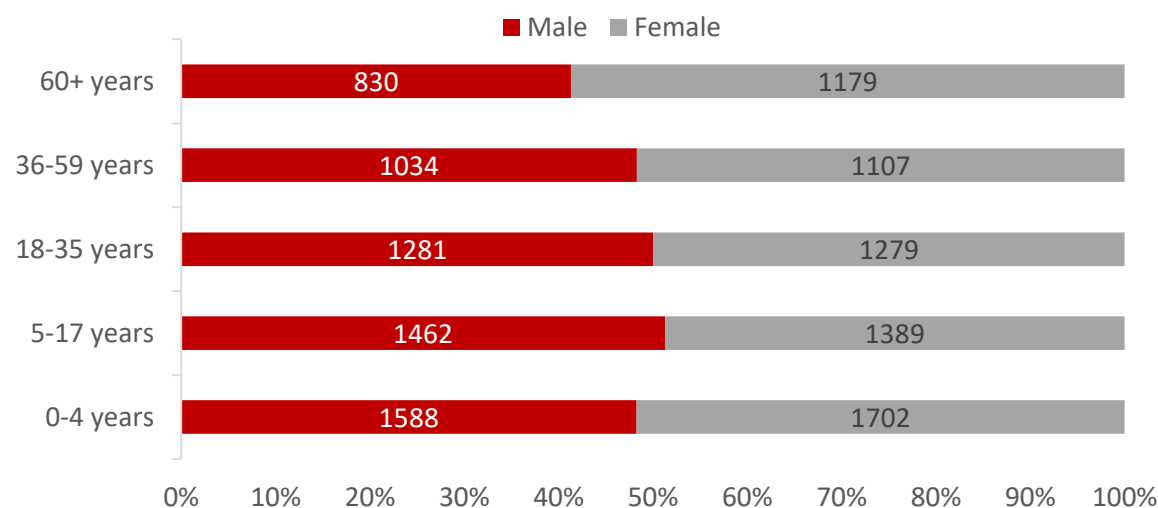

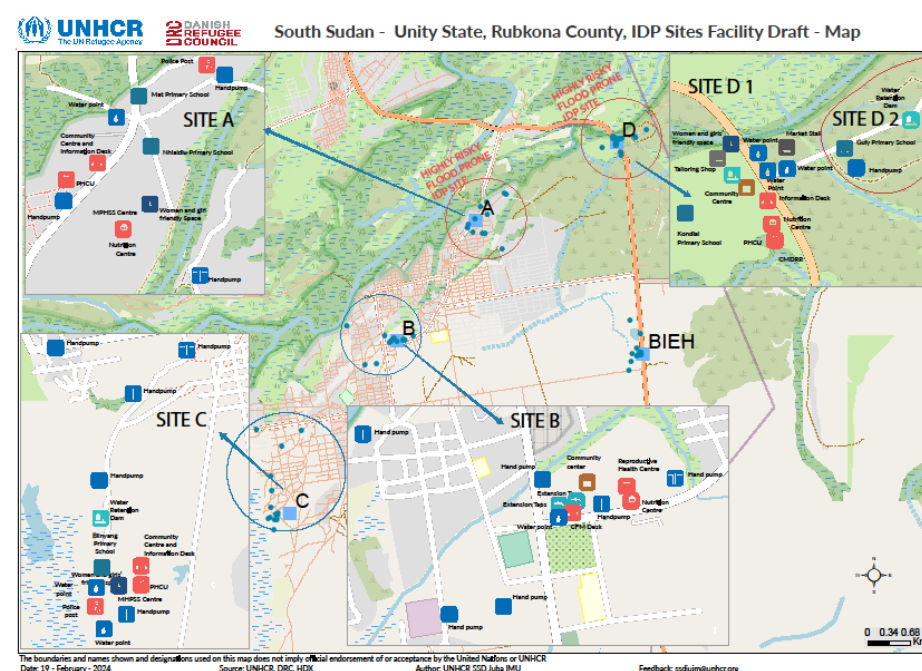
9% of the total children are unaccompanied or separated

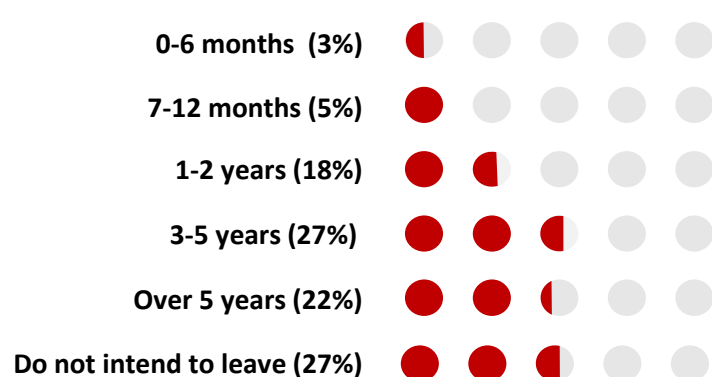

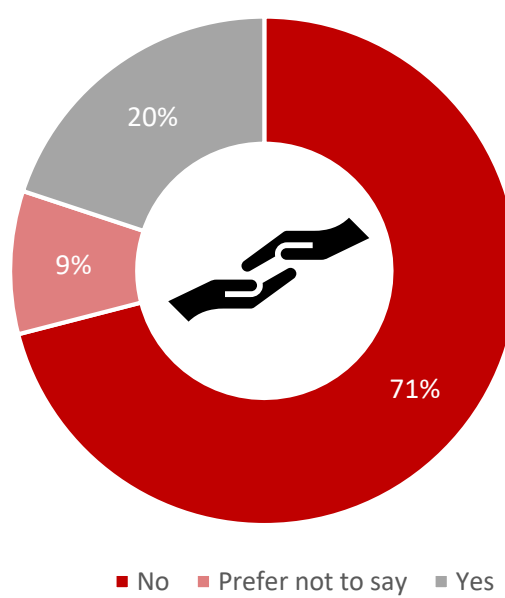
05 INTENTION ANALYSIS



Intention to stay on the sites

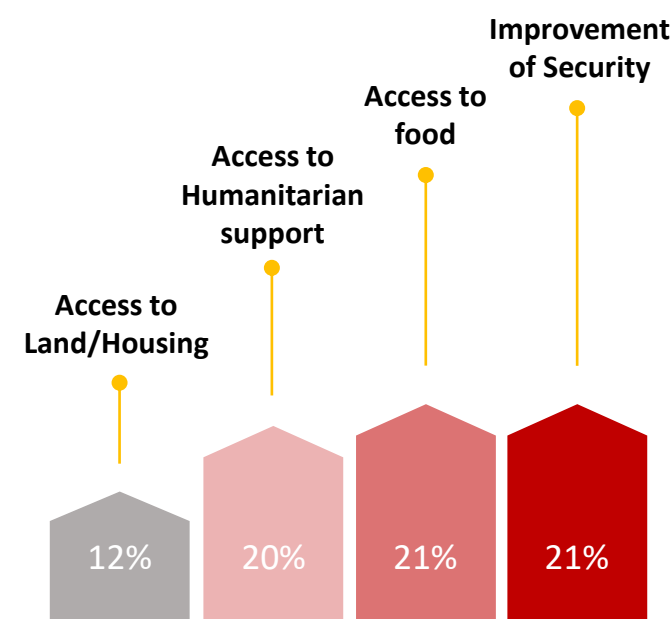
93% Families intend to stay in the current locations

84% of the people who are interested to leave the site, do not plan to leave with their whole family

Whether there is any external pressure to return/leave the site

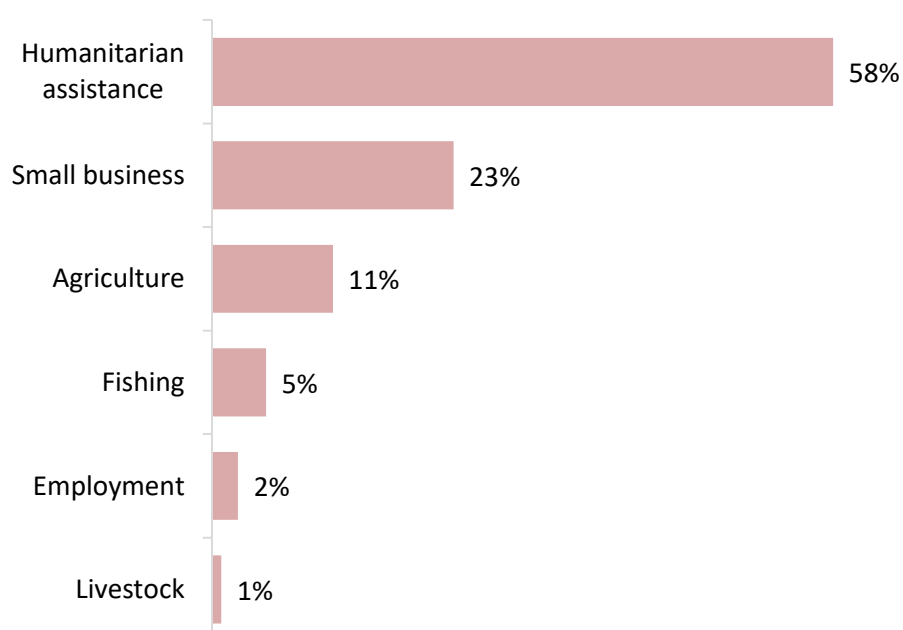


Top factors taken under consideration to stay/leave the sites

06 CAPACITY & RESOURCES

33% Families reported to have no source of income

58% Families consider humanitarian assistance as their only source of income



Main sources of income

27% of the families have access to land for agricultural or income generating purposes in this location

32% of the families have been able to secure access to land for housing in this location

57% of the families own land in this area or elsewhere in South Sudan

16% of the families reported to have housing land or property related issues

48% of the families have been registered under DTM or SCOPE.
