

CCCM Cluster 2024 Annual Incidents Report

853 Total incidents |

Overview Situation:

In 2024, totally 853 incidents were reported affecting over 69,900 individuals in 569 IDP sites in NWS. Majority of the incidents took place in mainly Dana, Maaret Tamsrin, Atareb, Azaz, and Afrin sub-districts. Nature of incidences include Fire (481), Flood (201), Wind (132), Clashes (11), Bombardement (7), and other type (20) of incidents.

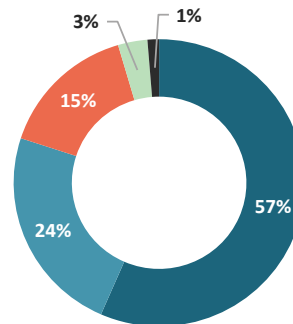
The incidents had a substantial impact, affecting approximately 16,200 households and destroying or damaging over 12,075 tents/shelters across 26 sub-districts. Unfortunately, 29 death cases and 124 injuries were documented mainly due to fire, bombardement, and clashes.

Response:

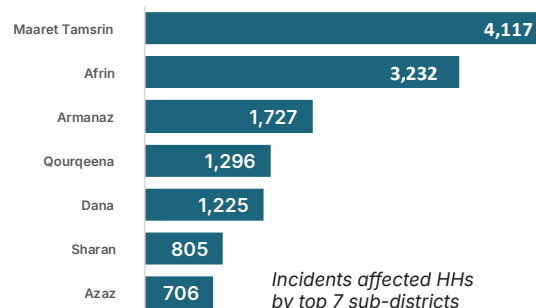
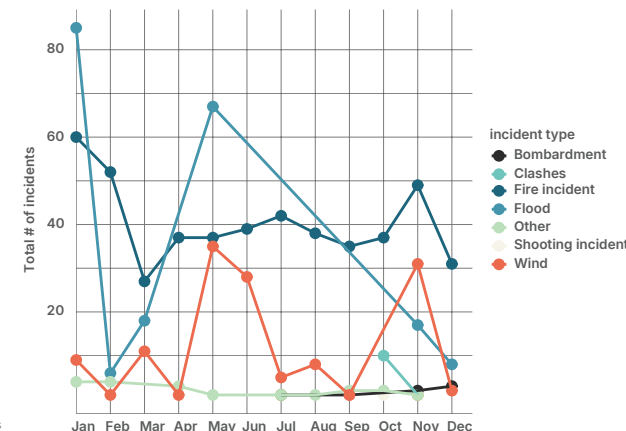
- 130 Fire points were established in 61 IDP sites through CCCM Cluster partners.
- Awareness raising on fire mitigation conducted for 34,733 individuals.
- CCCM ensured coordinated response to the affected sites to avoid any duplications.
- 536 incidents received appropriate and timely responses out of 853 incidents.
- 202,291 individuals benefited from fire mitigation and prevention activities that involve distributing fire extinguishing, fire blankets and different fire mitigation tools.

Challenges and Constraints:

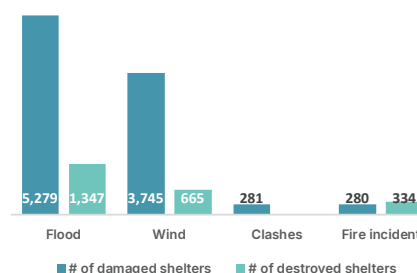
- 38 % of incidents did not receive any response.
- 988 IDP sites hosting over one million individuals are classified as "extreme" based on availability of basic services and weather condition.
- Vulnerable IDP sites require the full package of core CCCM activities to support prevention and response to disasters and incidents expected this winter.
