

# Site Management - Update 3

GAZA RESPONSE

# **GENERAL INFORMATION ON THE SITES ASSESSED:**

- NRC conducted site assessments to understand displacement movements through structured Key Informant Interviews (KIIs) with site focal points
- Ceasefire site-to-site assessment covered today 4571 individuals and 964 hh living across 5 sites in Deir al Balah (%) and Khan Younis (1/5).
- In the majority of the sites (%) no changes in the population at the site were reported. On the sites where people were leaving, only 2 hh (10 individuals) reportedly left the site.

# **MOVEMENT INTENTIONS**

- In most sites (1/5) KIs reported that most people or half of the people at the site intend to move to a different governorate. In 3/5 sites, KIs reported that people would be moving to another site, and on one of the sites, the KI reported that people would be moving to their own homes or relatives' homes.
- In one site, the KI reported not knowing what people on the site might do.
- Gaza is the most reported governorate where people will be moving to (3/5). Deir al Balah, Khan Younis, Rafah, and North Gaza were also mentioned by 1 Kl each.

# **KEY POPULATION NEEDS**

- The most reported sectors of humanitarian assistance are: MPCA (mentioned by all 5KIs), Food Security (4/5), NFIs (3/5), Shelter (4/5), and Health (1/5).
- On food assistance, KIs particularly mentioned the need for food vouchers or cash transfers and in-kind food distribution.
- The most reported NFIs needed were kitchen sets, blankets, and clothes.

# **HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE RECEIVED**

 Only ½ sites reported having received humanitarian assistance in the past 7 days. The assistance received was WASH assistance.



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## **KYS1571 - JAZIRAT AL-HAYAA CAMP**

- · As of today (23 January), only two household have left the site
- Around 50% of site residents plan to move to another site in Khan Younis governorate.

# **DEB0518 - ZAWAIDA SCHOOL**

- · No movement was observed at the site
- Most of the site residents (75%) plan to move to a site in the Gaza governorate
- According to the focal point, no assistance has been provided and site residents need support with transportation.

# DEB4014 - AL-EADALAT AL-QANUNIA CAMP

- No movement observed at the site
- Half of site residents (50%) plan to move to a site in Gaza governorate
- Site residents need support with transportation.

# **DEB2284 - ABU ASAD SHELTER**

- · No movement was observed at the site
- Most of the site residents (75%) plan to move to their own homes or relatives' homes in Rafah, North Gaza, Gaza, Deir Al Balah (Middle Area)
- Site residents from Rafah visited their homes and returned to the site.
- Site residents need cash support for transportation costs and to buy necessary items for return.

## **DEB4011 - AL-SHATE AL-JANOUBI**

- · No movement was observed at the site
- The site resident didn't decide on moving out site and the focal point doesn't know where people plan to move
