GAZA RESPONSE

Governorate: Khan Younis - Deir Al Balah

GENERAL INFORMATION ON THE SITES ASSESSED:

- NRC conducted site assessments to understand displacement movements through structured Key Informant Interviews (KIIs) with site focal points
- The assessment covers **19,979 individuals** and **3,931 hh** living in **13 sites** in the governorates of Deir al Balah (12) and Khan Younis (1)
- 10/13 sites reported no changes in the population at the site. While on 3 sites KIIs reported people were leaving. On these 3 sites, the total reported population that left **was 433 individuals (86 households)**.

MOVEMENT INTENTIONS

- In 8 sites, KIIs reported that everyone (4/8 sites), most (2/8), or half (2/8) of the population at the site is planning on moving to a different governorate. In 5 sites, people reportedly will go to other sites in different governorates, while in 3 of the sites, people reportedly will go to their homes or relatives' homes. In 2 sites, KIIs reported that people are planning to stay at the site.
- The most reported governorates to which people will be moving were North Gaza (8/8) and Gaza (4/8).

KEY POPULATION NEEDS

- Most reported sectors of humanitarian need are: WASH (mentioned by 9/13 KIIs), MPCA (9/13), NFIs (8/13), Food Security (7/13), and Shelter assistance (5/13).
- In WASH sector the most needed assistance was reportedly hygiene kits (9/13), drinking water (5/13) and water for domestic use (5/13)
- Among NFIs, the most needed items were reportedly blankets or mats (7/13), kitchen sets (6/13), and clothing (5/13)
- In the Food Security sector, the most needed assistance was reportedly in-kind food distribution (6/13) and food vouchers or cash transfers (5/13).

HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE RECEIVED

- In 8/13 sites KIIs reported some humanitarian assistance had been received in the past 7 days. Most reported sectors of humanitarian assistance received were: WASH (6/13), Shelter (4/13), Food Security (3/13), NFIs (3/13), MPCA (3/13).
